Thank you for submitting the *Walnut Creek Watershed Action Plan* to EPA Region 4 as an alternative restoration approach in advance of TMDL development. Region 4 staff have reviewed the information provided, which contains all the information necessary to allow the submittal to be uploaded into ATTAINS. Once that step is completed, the plan will be recognized and the waters to which it applies will be included under the 303(d) national performance measures.

The description of the alternative restoration approach and the waters to which it applies should be included during the public review of the draft 303(d) list or Integrated Report. This will allow the public an opportunity to review the state's alternative restoration approaches and the assigned priority ranking for TMDL development.

We also want to thank Cam for the presentation that he provided to us and EPA-HQ staff yesterday on this project. It is always great to see how states create tools to keep everybody informed of activities in the various watersheds. Your efforts are a great example that we would like to share with others in the future.
